Minutes of March 19, 1986

The Treasurer's report showing an on hand balance of \$29,987.41 was submitted and accepted.

Warrants totaling \$2,642.55 were submitted and approved for payment.

A resolution to join the California
State Surplus Property System was
introduced and approved 3-0.

Approval was given to submit an
application for an Errors and
Omissions Policy for Board members.

Request by Humeck for replacement
of a 100 foot tape measure
broken while lining out the
Dolomite Ditch work. Replacement
OK'd by Krigger and Spangler.

adjourned to the next regular
meeting.
