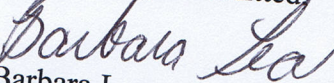
Discussion was held on the road stripping for parts of Crystal Blvd., in areas that would not be having a coat of double chip-seal. And Dolomite could be done with centerline stripping. Mr. Reeder informed to board that there is white paint available at present for some work to begin as soon as the weather permits.

There is some question brought up about just how much the District is able to do for the people on the sub-division roads. There is a difference between the district mapping and the sub-division maps. It maybe that we would need an authorization from the residents on the sub-division roads to do any roadwork because there maybe a situation regarding easements. This will be looked into further and be reported back. The board agrees that we would like to have all the roads all done with the same uniformity. LAFCO will be getting back to us on this matter.

Frank Lombard presented a draft for the new bid package for the year 2002, using some of the recommendations from the El Dorado County Transportation Specifications. There would need to be some fine-tuning and adjustments to this new package mostly because of the money available. Mr. Lombard cautioned the board to be very careful and thorough before putting the package out to bid.

The meeting was adjourned by the Chuck Schultz.
